### **Dress Rehearsal Reminders:**

- Dancers **arrive dressed** in costume.
- Light make-up encouraged for all rehearsals and recitals.
- Please no underwear under tights!
- No jewelry-gum-food.
- Dancers sit with your parents in their assigned spot. Look for a picture of their costume next to their row (Alliance Convention Center) or bench (Miss Kim's).
- Teachers will call dancers up to stage/room when it is their turn. Dancers will perform their routine 1-2 times.
- Do not leave until you hear their teacher say **"this class is finished"**.
- **Parents remain with dancers the entire time at Dress Rehearsals.**
- *Ballet: Ballet Bun (all hairpieces go on the right side of the bun)*
- *All other genres of dance: \*Low bun with a left side part (at nape of neck) unless a teacher emails you with specific requests. Younger ages may not have enough hair for a low bun so just make sure it is back away from the face.*

- **Arrive 30 min before recital-NO SOONER.**
- Check in your dancer to the “back stage” area when you arrive (**no dance bag or water bottle**) which is the open space adjacent to the auditorium. After checking in your dancer you get into the line to enter the auditorium.
- Dancers **arrive dressed** in costume. Hair in ballet bun for Sleeping Beauty-Low bun/left side part for Broadway Bound.
- Light make-up encouraged for all rehearsals and recitals.
- Please no underwear under tights!
- No jewelry-gum-food.
- **Miss Page will open the “house doors” 30 minutes before the show begins.**
- Parents and guests can take a seat in the auditorium.
- **NO TICKETS-You may bring as many guests as you would like!**
- After the end of the recital pick up your dancer at the backstage area. **GO OUT THE EXIT DOORS-THEY WILL SAY EXIT-DO NOT GO OUT THE DOORS YOU ENTERED THE AUDITORIUM IN.**
- Enjoy this moment with your dancer, take pictures, buy goodies/gifts from our store, and celebrate together.
